### Guidelines for Poster Presentations

#### POSTER SESSION INSTRUCTIONS

The IGLC15 poster session is scheduled for Thursday July 19 2007 from 10:30am to 11:30am. During this session all papers will be discussed simultaneously. Your display must be attended at all times during the session by you or a coauthor. Please leave posters up throughout the meeting for the meeting attendees to view.

#### POSTER SESSION SET-UP TIMES

Thursday, July 19, 2007 from 7:00–10:15 a.m.

Please review these guidelines carefully and prepare your poster presentation and materials accordingly. Please note that poster sessions are different from traditional sessions in the following ways:

- Slides and visual aids should be limited to those that can be displayed on a 4' x 4' poster board and read at a distance of a few feet. (SEE SAMPLE POSTER BOARD GRAPHIC below)

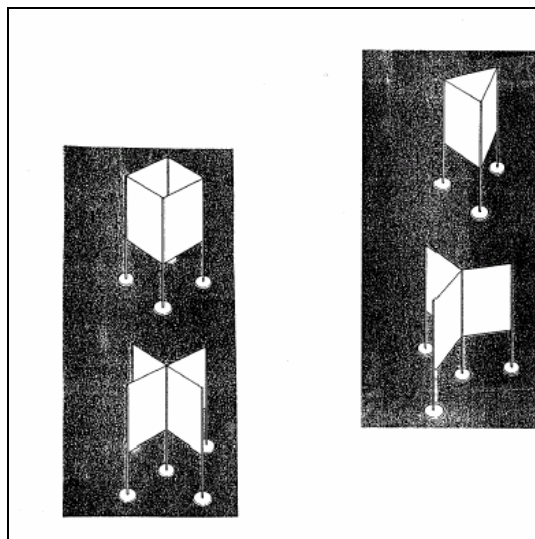


Figure 1: Sample Poster Board at IGLC15

- The authors should be prepared to discuss the papers and not read the slides to participants.
- The discussion nature of poster session allow authors to present more complex figures.

THE CONFERENCE WILL FURNISH THE FOLLOWING:

- One 4' x 4' poster board
- Supplies: marking pens, Velcro, scissors, heavy paper stock

SPEAKERS MUST FURNISH THE FOLLOWING:

- Slides as outlined in the example PowerPoint (see below) – Again it's important slides are sized and lettered to be legible from a few feet away.
- Handouts - It is strongly recommended that speakers provide handouts. Make sure to bring the number of handouts you will need (about 75).

SET-UP and TEARDOWN INSTRUCTIONS:

- **Mount your slides on the poster board using the provided Velcro. Glue the hard side of the Velcro fastener slip provided to the back of your slides or display. If what you are mounting is heavy, be sure to use enough Velcro strips. The hard side of the Velcro will stay in place on the soft fabric of the Poster Board panel.**
- **No tape or push pins can be used as it damages the boards.**
- Remove all of your materials from the poster board immediately after the end of the presentation period. The conference is not responsible for materials left in the room after the presentation period.

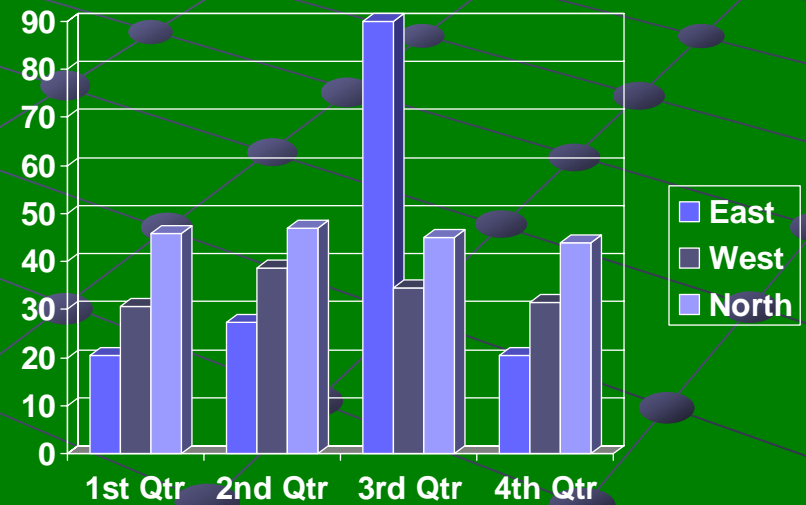
